

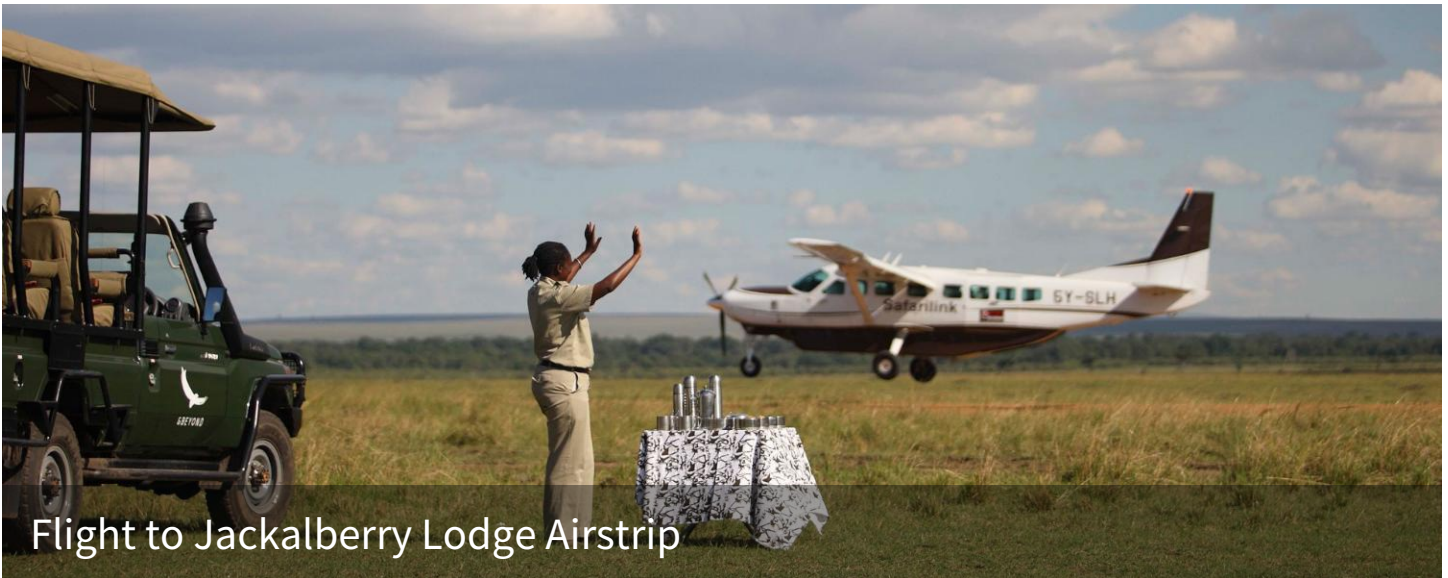

## From Franschhoek to Cape Town

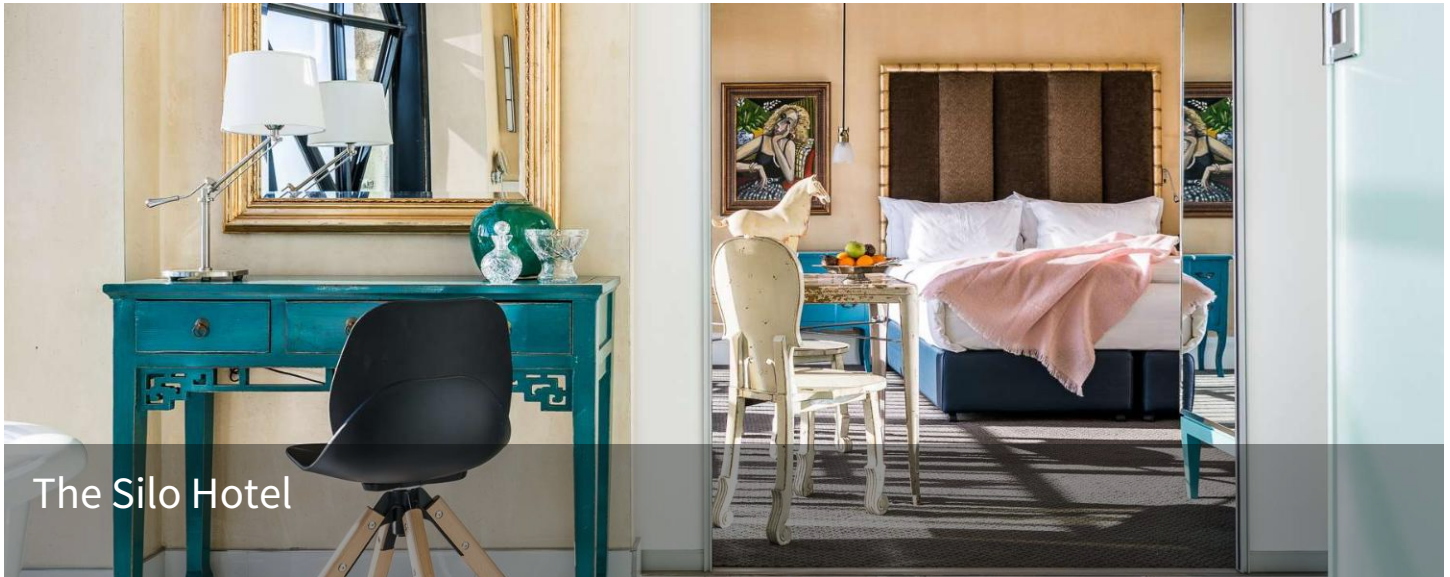

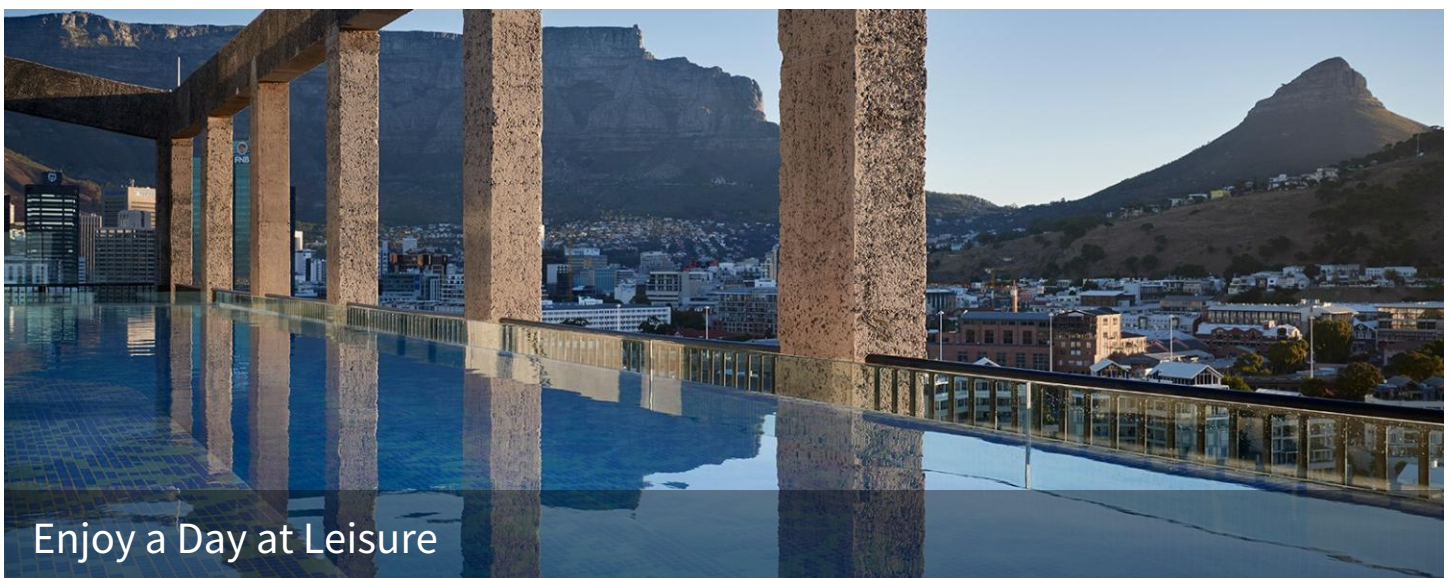
